Bottling Station Relocation Announcement

The Water Department would like to notify the public that the bottling station at Mount Nebo Park was switched over to the winter-time location beginning on Monday, November 14, 2016.

Station users may continue to fill bottles throughout the cold weather months by using the station in the front of the Globe Hollow Water Treatment Facility on 125 Spring Street. Please use the driveway just to the west of the Mount Nebo entrance and bear left when entering the parking lot.

When visiting the station, please follow the signs, yield the right-of-way to exiting vehicles, be considerate and patient with fellow bottlers, and only park in designated areas in order to prevent accidents. This free water is tasty, but your personal safety is our primary concern.

This wintertime station is accessible from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday excluding weekends and holidays. For more information visit our website at www.townofmanchester.org/water or call us at 860-647-3115.

The Water Department appreciates your understanding and we look forward to next spring when expanded hours and regular weekend/holiday accessibility can be resumed at Mount Nebo Park.
